

# GARY REPORT

## The Moses And Elijah Works Fulfilled By Two Men—Part 2

In the original "Report" prior to this I noted: "Thus it seems in every regard that this culminating latter-day work is the Gary work, fulfilling that which was begun in the Peter work, separated by the Paul work." This would be the Peter first Remnant work, followed by the Paul Christianity work, and culminates with the Gary second Remnant work. We know that Peter was taught by the Son of God, not by just any man. So, what about Paul? Who taught him? In Galatians 1:11, 12, and 15-17 we find a clear declaration as to the origin of the understanding and knowledge he received.

For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but *I received it* through a revelation of Jesus Christ. ... But when God, who had set me apart *even* from my mother's womb and called me through His grace, was pleased to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with flesh and blood, nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went away to Arabia, and returned once more to Damascus.

No natural man taught Peter, and no natural man taught Paul. They were both uniquely taught by God. And in June, 1994, the same thing began to happen to me. Man did not teach me these things that I now know, but God alone equally taught me. In that initial time I could ask Him any question and He would answer it. And He told me things that no man has ever known or seen or even imagined—neither the prophets, nor Peter, nor Paul. These were the revelations of God. And to insure that I was in fact hearing from Him, I quickly found that the Scriptures completely and thoroughly and consistently confirmed all that He was teaching me. And this has been true up to this day. No man before me has understood what the kingdom of heaven truly is and what the Father is doing, particularly regarding today. Do I know the exact timing of His fulfillments? Not the exact day, but we are in that period when these things will be fulfilled, or He would not have revealed them to me. And for the reasons I have stated thus far, it is evident that they are being and will be thoroughly fulfilled today. As I wrote in the previous Report:

The fact and reality is, the man Peter was the rock on which Yahshua built His church. But that work breached, and Christianity was then built on the man Saul/Paul. BOTH of these works had to begin with "a man," as has been the way of Yahweh since Adam. And it is most evident that today the initiating Peter Moses work must be completed by, if I am seeing all things clearly, the Gary Elijah work.

And as has been in each of these works, this work today is “‘Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit’ says Yahweh of hosts” (Zechariah 4:6). And most importantly, that specific work in whole was a Peter olive tree, followed by the breach-Christianity seven-branched-lampstand Paul work, and culminates with the Gary olive tree work and the coming of Immanuel to establish His kingdom!

Someone might say to me, “You’re being presumptuous.” One does not learn and see the things I have learned from God and say I am being presumptuous. They are too certain, being profoundly supported from Genesis to Revelation, and since 1994 the Father has kept me to be faithful to these truths—though it has cost me my entire family, and more. But He has preserved me and blessed me, and in Africa we are seeing the awesomeness of this truth taking root—across that entire vast continent, and continues to this very day!

And, I WILL NOT make the mistake that Peter made. In Galatians 2:11 we see in type where the first Remnant went wrong, or one could say where the breach of the church began.

But when Cephas [Peter] came to Antioch, I [Paul] opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned.

I ask you, where did Christianity begin? It was none other than in Antioch, the very place where Peter went. In type and testimony, the first Remnant turned to and went into Christianity—and the outcome was the corruption of the Bride, evidenced by Peter’s actions here. Paul openly rebuked him, and furthermore recorded it for all to see. And today, we the Bride must not stay in Antioch Christianity or we too are condemned. Our place is not under the Paul Christianity work, but under (if I may) the Gary Bride work. And I say this not to take glory as a man—not at all, for I know I am but a simple man—but to give glory to God who called a man out of Antioch Christianity and opened his eyes to see things that no other man has ever even come close to seeing—not of myself but according to the will and grace of God the Father.

And let me add another relevant testimony here. In about 1978, the Father sovereignly called me into the ministry, and I mean sovereignly. When He did so, I fell on my face before Him, actually crying out “Oh no!” A year later I went to see my former pastor about this, and he suggested I go see a professor at Christ For The Nations, a Bible college in Dallas, Texas. I made an appointment with him and met him in his church office. I told him my experience, and here is what he said to me: “I have two doctorate degrees, and with a quarter I might be able to get me a cup of coffee. My suggestion to you is that you go home, sit down at your desk, and read and study that Bible.” It was the best council I could have ever received—and from a pastor and professor—and I have never regretted that course for my life. God’s plan for me was not seminary, learning the ways and ideas of fallen man, but to teach me Himself and show me things that NO other man has ever seen or known before. The Son of God taught Peter, God taught Paul in the wilderness, and God chose to teach me and thereby see things that no man has ever seen before—all to His glory and for the coming of Immanuel! Amen and amen!

There is no way man could figure out all of these things, but the Spirit revealed them to me. And this work of the Spirit is truth for each and every one who hears it and believes. And why is it that Americans and elsewhere are blind and unreceptive to this truth, yet both Christians and Muslims alike in Africa see and readily accept it with ease and great wonder and joy? Again, no man taught Paul, and no man has taught me. These are consummating works of the Father according to His will and plan. It is the [donkey](#) carrying Him into Jerusalem, while His chosen people lay down their palm branches, as well as their garments, preparing the way for Him.

Am I being presumptuous, my brothers and sisters? I know what I am—a mere common man. But I also know what I see, and it is far beyond what any man could imagine or conceive. And I look to the Father to fulfill His word and work.

“Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass” (1 Thessalonians 5:24).
