And equally significant, none of these blessings are listed in Christianity Mark. They are the two-thousand-year breach, with which we today are all too familiar!

So again, what did Yahshua say to us, the concluding and fulfilling second Remnant? We too have to become poor, giving up everything. And it appears that that fulfillment is now beginning. And, after the seven trips to Kenya, the way is opening for us to go to India, specifically New Delhi. And, we did not receive the latter rain in Kenya, and it appears that that could come in India. And regarding these two outcomes, we see first the image of Satan on Africa, then second the like image on India, but now that of a man, and Satan's horn has distinctly been broken off!
