GARY REPORT

Understanding What God Is Doing, Part 1

Following is communication I had with Rian Burger in Australia per the writings posted here of late. Upon reading "<u>Very Important Message</u>," posted on the "Gary Report" on 7-2-19, he replied with his response on 7-7-19. I will not provide that email here, for my response back to him incorporated much of his email within it. I believe you will find this correspondence most enlightening and encouraging. Following is my email response on 7-9-19.

Rian,

You wrote concerning Satan's corruption of the kingdom:

"It was inevitable, it had to happen."

Unfortunately you are right. You also wrote:

"What's interesting is that he had rights before Adam and Even sinned."

Indeed.

Yes, Satan did in fact have the kingdom and had rights from the foundation of the earth. These are the same rights we, the Bride, will now have. He/she failed. You could even see him/her as a first bird. In fact when he/she offered the whole world to Yahshua while in the wilderness, he/she loses it and it in fact goes to the Bride. It was all timing, and Yahshua probably even knew then that it would go to the Bride. He just had to wait for that transference.

And keep in mind, no child could be born until after the fall. It is evident that Satan had the responsibility for the births of mankind — the serpent sperm being cast down to the earth egg. And this was confirmed in the wilderness when he/she could offer all of it to Yahshua. She had to birth mankind in the flesh, and she owned it. While we are in this flesh, she is the mother of all mankind. The fact is this earth is from below: "And He was saying to them, 'You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world" (John 8:23).

If Yahshua was before His time, and so Christianity was also before their time as well, could one say that the Garden of Eden representing the kingdom of God, was also before it's time, since it was not created on the 7th day.

Technically, yes. That "first bird" principle is vastly impacting here.

It also makes me wonder what gave Satan the right to be in the Garden in the first place? Could it be because Yahweh had made a covenant with Lucifer as his wife to produce offspring, but since Lucifer got proud, she was separated from Yahweh.

Indeed. This is obviously why Yahshua's body was not created by the serpent sperm. It looked to us today when we as well will be born from above, most importantly not from the first-bird work of Satan which leads to death.

but by being one with Yahweh because of covenant, she had rights to the kingdom?

Yes, she definitely had rights to the kingdom, for we have been her offspring, evidenced by being born of the serpent sperm. The first 6,000 years all belonged to her. That is why she was in the Garden. It was to be hers. She had to bring forth offspring. Why? No one can be born from above if they were not first born from below. Death, burial, resurrection proves this. One cannot experience the heavenly, unless they first experience the earthly. This is why Yahshua came here as a man first, and then tasted of death for all mankind. He had to open the way, so that we could thereby follow. He was the link between Satan's creation work that is below, and the Father's heavenly experience that is above. And as addressed in the writing on the <u>Nazirite vow</u>, He opened the way. And again, we all have to go through that process.

Unless Satan is removed, the kingdom will continue to be corrupted.

Very much so.

Satan needs to be removed from the garden/kingdom and bound for the full duration so that Yahweh could set up His Kingdom without corruption.

Yes. His/her work is done, finished. He/she birthed the natural, and with that being accomplished the second fulfilling work can be fulfilled. And in truth, the second fulfilling work could only take place because of the preceding death and corruption work. Speaking in general, there is no resurrection and ascension without the preceding death and burial work. (Of course the Bride is a natural exception to this.) At large, the Father takes the natural, and with it He can then fulfill the spiritual. Thus from 1 Cor. 15:42-49 we read:

So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable *body*, it is raised an imperishable *body*; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual *body*. So also it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living soul." The last Adam *became* a life-giving spirit. However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural; then the spiritual. The first man is from the earth, earthy; the second man is from heaven. As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are

heavenly. Just as we have borne the image of the earthy, we will also bear the image of the heavenly.

And you close regarding the male and female. It is interesting that in the Garden on this earth the man was created first and from the dust of the earth, and then the woman was created. But there is now going to be a flip and the first will be last and the last first. Now, the feminine Bride is created first in heaven, followed later by the masculine Body of Christ. And of course the latter heavenly birth experience is the true and much needed fulfillment. Even so, the former was essential, for you cannot have the heavenly unless there is first the earthly. Interesting. Your comments?

Then on 7-10-19 Rian replied:

Gary,

Thank you for your detailed feedback; this was excellent. Quite a few additional thoughts came from reading this, and it also seems to tie in a bit with the latest report as well: "The Left Hand of God."

You wrote:

Yes, Satan did in fact have the kingdom and had rights from the foundation of the earth. These are the same rights we, the Bride, will now have. He/she failed. You could even see him/her as a first bird. In fact when he/she offered the whole world to Yahshua while in the wilderness, he/she loses it and it in fact goes to the Bride. It was all timing, and Yahshua probably even knew then that it would go to the Bride. He just had to wait for that transference.

Before I read your email, I had this interesting thought about two kings in the Bible who offered half of the kingdom to two women. Of course you would know who they are:

- 1. King Ahasuerus offered "half of the kingdom" to Esther on three occasions.
- 2. King Herod offered "half of the kingdom" to his daughter, or rather it was the daughter of Herodias.

So based on what you said that it in fact goes to the Bride, it makes me wonder if those two offers made by those two kings testify of the split Bride, each receiving an offer to "half of the kingdom," but they chose different outcomes.

Here are some of my thoughts about this:

• Both women did something that caused them to find favor in the eyes of the king.

- The outcomes of both offers were very different—one lead to death, and the other lead to life.
- Two halves of course make one whole, which would make sense in terms of the "split" Bride that would obtain the full rights of the kingdom from Satan. Interestingly, the testimony of two halves is also found in Esther as the king offered her "half of the kingdom" at the first and second banquets, most likely also testifying of the first and second Remnants receiving the rights to the kingdom. But importantly, unlike Christianity who "took the bait" and took up the offer, the Bride does not even take the offer from Yahweh, nor will she take the offer from Satan. It already belongs to her by virtue of who she is. Instead, she is concerned in reversing the curse of death of Satan on God's people.

Here are some more thoughts on the different responses to the offer of "half of the kingdom":

- The first Remnant Herodias daughter chose the head of John the Baptist, which is in type the Elijah, but she did this under the influence of her mum, Herodias—most likely here representing Satan. This would testify of the first Remnant listening to Satan like Eve did, which resulted in death to the promise of the Elijah coming to restore all things.
- The second Remnant Esther Bride chose instead to expose Satan. Contrary to Herodias asking for the Elijah's head, she instead listened to the Mordecai Elijah who directed her to expose Haman Satan to the king/King. The result of this led to the ultimate reversal of the curse of death on God's people.

Rian's next statement is a wonderful hope regarding our attitude.

I'm not sure how accurate the above is, but what stands out to me, and is very encouraging, is that the Bride is not tempted with an offer to have the rights to the kingdom, not even from Yahweh, but is more interested in seeking a solution to overcoming death for God's people. Even the first Remnant did not take up the offer, but unfortunately made a mistake by listening to Satan, which resulted in death to the promise.

Regarding what you wrote in your email to me:

In fact when he/she offered the whole world to Yahshua while in the wilderness.

Is that the same as what Paul addressed in 1 Cor. 5v1?

It is reported commonly that there is **fornication** among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, **that one should have his father's wife.**

Was Satan in fact tempting Yahshua with fornication, with laying with his Father's wife? You've mentioned on occasions in the past that what Yahshua

rejected, the Body of Christ accepted. It would seem that what Paul is mentioning here is related to that temptation in the wilderness. After all, the Body of Christ has been in the wilderness for 2,000 years serving Satan, as they did indeed take up the offer from him/her.

This is what Christians have done—laying with Satan, even the god of this world; seeking the world; laying with the Father's wife.

Just diverging here for a moment, likewise, did they turn stones into bread? Yes, it would seem that way as pastors and ministers have been eating and digesting "God's wrath and judgments," and then feeding it to the people as dung (as you've pointed out in some of your writings). Yahshua's response was appropriate in Matt. 4:4: "It is written, man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." Christians have been living off these wrath teachings for 2,000 years, instead of every word that comes from the mouth of God. Did they jump off the pinnacle of the temple and have angels bear them up? I think the answer is a definite "No" to the angels bearing them up, since Christianity cannot ascend alive as you've pointed out many times. As to jumping off the pinnacle of the temple, this would result in their death. After all, they have been dying for two thousand years.

Regarding the "left hand of God," I have this thought that seems to tie in with what is written above in regards to Satan. It is well accepted that the left brain controls the right side of the body, and the right brain controls the left side of the body. Here's a quote from the internet:

The left side of the brain is responsible for controlling the right side of the body. It also performs tasks that have to do with **logic**, such as in science and mathematics. On the other hand, the right hemisphere coordinates the left side of the body, and performs tasks that have do with **creativity** and the arts.

What is revealing about this is that it seems quite relevant as to how Yahweh operates, including in terms of Satan's work and corruption. The left side is logic, and in terms of Yahweh this would be His governmental ways. This is the right hand of God that establishes His Government; and very appropriately, this is accomplished through His Son who is on His right side as well. On the other hand, regarding His left hand, I can understand why He would not want to mention it, as it's related to Satan. Interestingly and very revealingly, it's His creative side, and all of creation has been corrupted by Satan.

I had a few more thoughts but still have to get my head around them. This topic really fascinates me and must be quite important.
